Abstract Submission

Authors wishing to present their scientific results are asked to submit a **1-page abstract by March 31, 2017** via "Submission Form". The abstract should be typed single-spaced text including the title, author(s), affiliation(s) and address(es). Detail information for the format is seen in the template file for downloading.

The abstract should explicitly mention objective, new result, conclusion and significance of the work. The selection of the presentation either oral or poster will be based on the review of 1-page abstract by the organizing committee. The corresponding author of the selected papers will be informed via email.

Excellent poster presentation by a student will be awarded. Please nominate to poster award candidate in the abstract submission form, when the presenting author is a student wishing to nominate.

Either MS Word file or PDF file can be accepted.

Abstract submission form is opened from November 1, 2016 to March 31, 2017.

Note: To help ensure the accuracy of the final program (and out of respect for the other participants), presenters of both oral and poster presentations must complete the payment of the registration fee by **September 15th (extended), 2017**. Failure of the presenter to respond favorably to this request will result in the presentation being removed from the final program.

Proceedings

Proceedings are encouraged to be submitted, although it is **NOT MANDATORY**.

Proceedings submitted are peer-reviewed and accepted articles will be published on website.

The manuscripts prepared as MS Word file together with PDF file (less than 2 MB for each file) should be submitted by e-mail to "isec2017proceeding@solventextraction.gr.jp" from **March 1 to July 31 (extended), 2017**.

Proceedings page length should be 4 - 8 pages. When you submit your manuscript by e-mail, please inform "Session category" and "Acceptance number" at your submission of abstract.

Since the original manuscript properly prepared is essential, any manuscript impossible to camera-ready publication will be rejected. The language should be English. Detail information for the proceeding preparation is seen in the template file for downloading.

Instruction for Presentation

Oral Presentation

A video projector and a notebook computer (Windows7, MS Office 2013, Adobe Acrobat Reader DC) will be provided in each oral presentation room.

Please bring your lecture as a PowerPoint- or PDF-file on a USB stick.

Your own computer can be also used. Please let the chairperson know before starting your session, if you want to use your own computer. If you prefer to use a Mac computer, please do not forget to bring the connector by yourself.

The time is 50 minutes for plenary lecture, 30 minutes for keynote lecture, and 20 minutes for general lecture. The time includes ca 5 minutes' discussion.

Poster Presentation

Space of each poster board is 90 cm in width and 210 cm in length.

Each poster should be in the size of 84 cm in width and 120 cm in length (A0 size).

Directly paste the poster on the poster board according to the presentation number.

Presentation number will be noticed at the top corner on the board.

Pins and tapes will be available in the presentation room.

Posters should be put on 10:00 – 13:30 and should be taken down 15:30 – 18:00 on November 7 (Tue).

The posters should be presented during the poster session, 13:30 – 15:30 on November 7 (Tue).

Poster presentation by a student will be evaluated by the committee, and several selected posters will be awarded.

Awarded authors of poster presentations will be invited to the banquet for commendation.
